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




FOUNDATION PHASE GRADE 2: STATIONERY LIST FOR 2025









- Please note that it is essential for every learner to have **all** the equipment on this list.
- All stationery must be brought to school on the Monday or Tuesday before school starts for learners.
- **All stationery must be clearly and individually labelled with your child's name.**
- Exercise books are supplied by the school, but are to be covered in a specific colour for easy access. A picture is completed as a name label by learners in class during the first week of school and is to be added on the front cover of each book. Each book then needs to be covered in plastic for durability.
- Books are to be covered by the **end of 2nd week** of the school year.
- Please note that reusing items that have been used in previous years is absolutely acceptable and encouraged.
- Kindly note that this stationery list is what your child will need in class during the **first two terms** of the year. A stationery top-up list will be issued at the end of Term 2. Unused stationery is kept in a container in the Teacher's store room and issued as the child needs it. Whatever is left over is returned to the child at the end of the year.
- Please be sure to have a set of stationery at home for your child to be able to complete homework activities when needed.










ELECTRONIC DEVICES

We have limited bandwidth and any additional unnecessary usage cannot be accommodated. Any misuse of the device will result in the device being confiscated immediately and handed to the parent. The misbehaviour will be addressed between the teacher, parent and learner before the device is returned to the learner.
